What is eczema?

Skin eczema is used to description all reddish, dryness, itching and thickening conditions of the skin. Eczema has several types, but the most common form of eczema is called atopic dermatitis. The skin is inflamed, itchy, rough and irritated without any obvious cause. Symptoms of eczema are often seen on the face, hands and feet, but can occur on any areas of the body. Eczema is very common in children and 20% of babies suffer from it. Symptoms of atopic eczema include dryness, redness, itching, inflammation and thickening of the skin surface. These lesions may be wounded due to scratching by baby's hand, and be infected.

Moisturizing the skin is the first important step in improving the symptoms of eczema. Also, applying the anti-inflammatory, redness and itching compounds are also very effective for improving eczema problems.
